Have you heard about the garlic diet?


You don't lose much weight, but from a distance your friends think you look thinner!

Which vegetable did Noah leave off the Ark?


Leeks.

Pears (pairs)!


Did you hear the joke about the watermelon?

It gives a little wine!




Why did the man at the orange juice factory lose his job?

With a pumpkin patch!


What vegetable might you find in your basement?
